Volunteering with MultiCare

Thank you for considering MultiCare Hospital System as a place to share your time! Our volunteers play a crucial role in helping support MultiCare's mission in partnering for healing and a healthy future. The onboarding process takes 4-5 weeks to complete. Get started today!

Volunteer requirements:

- Volunteers must commit to a weekly schedule (1x week), on the same day and time, for an assigned 3–4-hour shift.
- Volunteers must commit to volunteering a minimum of 100 hours of service. (takes 7-8 months to complete)
- Volunteers must be age 16 or older.
- Volunteers must demonstrate professionalism and independence. Volunteer positions are self-directed.
- Volunteers are required to complete a health screening (flu shots required during flu season)
- Volunteers must pass a criminal background check.

Steps to become a volunteer: You must complete steps 1-5 within the 4 weeks following the Information Session you attend.

Step 1 – Attend a 1 hour in-person [Good Sam Hospital Volunteer Services](#) Click link to see schedule.

Step 2 – After attending the Information Session, schedule a phone interview with a Volunteer Coordinator to find a volunteer role that matches your schedule and interests and complete the volunteer application.

Step 3 – Complete the New Volunteer Orientation training and sign up for the Onboarding meeting

Step 4 – Attend the New Volunteer Onboarding (in-person group meeting or virtual group meeting)

Step 5 – Complete required health screening

Step 6 – Attend Badge Pick Up Meeting

Step 7 – Complete Department specific training and turn in training checklist
