Volunteering with MultiCare

Thank you for considering MultiCare Hospital System as a place to share your time! Volunteers play a crucial role in helping support MultiCare's mission of: ***Partnering for healing and a healthy future.***

The onboarding process can take 4-5 weeks to complete.

Volunteer requirements:

- Volunteers must be 16 years old or older.
- Volunteers must demonstrate professionalism & independence. Volunteer positions are self-directed.
- Volunteers must commit to a weekly assigned 4-hour shift scheduled at the same time.
- Volunteers must commit to volunteering a minimum of 100 hours of service
- Volunteers are required to complete a health screening (flu shots required during the flu season).
- Volunteers must pass a criminal background check.

Steps to become a volunteer: You must complete steps 1-5 within the 4 weeks following the Information Session you attend.

Step 1 – Attend a 1 hour in-person Informational Session at either the Auburn or Covington Medical Centers Services.

Step 2 – After attending the Information Session, schedule a phone interview with a Volunteer Manager to find a volunteer role that matches your schedule & interests. And complete the volunteer application.

Step 3 – Complete the New Volunteer Orientation training & sign up for an Onboarding meeting

Step 4 – Attend the in-person New Volunteer Onboarding meeting.

Step 5 – Complete required health screening

Step 6 – Attend Badge Pick Up Meeting

Step 7 – Complete Department specific training and turn in training checklist.
