

## Enabling SSL Versions TLS 1.1 & TLS 1.2

### **Internet Explorer:**

1. Open Internet Explorer
2. Press Alt T and select "Internet Options".
3. Select the "Advanced" tab.
4. Scroll down to the "Security" section.
5. Locate and check "Use TLS 1.1 and TLS 1.2".
6. Then, click the "OK" button.

### **Google Chrome:**

1. Open Google Chrome
2. Press Alt F and select "Settings".
3. Scroll down and select "Show advanced settings..."
4. Scroll down to the Network section and click on "Change proxy settings..."
5. Select the "Advanced" tab.
6. Scroll down to the "Security" section.
7. Locate and check "Use TLS 1.1 and TLS 1.2".
8. Then, click the "OK" button.

### **FireFox:**

1. Open FireFox
2. Type in "about:config" in the URL bar and press Enter
3. Scroll down to "security.tls.version.max" and press enter
4. Set the value to 3
5. Then, click the "OK" button.

### **Opera:**

1. Open Opera
2. Press Ctrl+F12
3. Click on "Security"
4. Click on "Security Protocols..."
5. Check on "Enable TLS 1.1 & TLS 1.2"
6. Click the "OK" button.
7. Then, click the "OK" button.

### **Safari:**

1. There are no options for enabling SSL protocols. If you are using Safari version 7 or greater, TLS 1.1 & 1.2 are automatically enabled.
