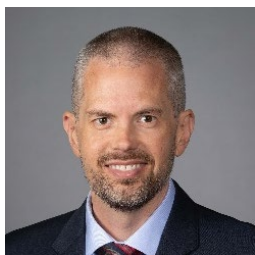

<p>Services What clinical services and procedures are offered?</p>	<p>Prostate cancer screening</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Shared decision making encouraged in men ages 55-69 Screening entails PSA/DRE every 1-2 years <p>BPH</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Obstructive symptoms (weak stream, difficulty starting, intermittency) trial alpha blocker 4-6 weeks Irritative symptoms (urgency, frequency, nocturia) trial anticholinergics or beta 3 agonist (Myrbetriq) x 3 months If patients remain unsatisfied, refer to urologist Many new and exciting minimally invasive prostate procedure are available <p>Microscopic hematuria</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Always obtain microscopic analysis, POC UA not sufficient Refer if > 3 RBC/HPF <p>Gross hematuria</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> R/O UTI with culture 20 per cent risk of GU malignancy Refer to urologist <p>Kidney stones</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Obtain non contrast CT prior to referral <p>Urologic malignancy</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Always refer 	<p>Recurrent urinary tract infections</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> AUA defines as > 3 culture proven UTI's in the past year or 2 culture proven UTI's in 6 months Always obtain urine culture if infection is suspected Treatment goal is to reduce frequency – unlikely to prevent all infections Prevention – adequate hydration, OTC cranberry extract, methenamine 1 gm PO BID, vaginal estrogens, daily prophylactic antibiotic as last resort Refer to infectious disease for multi drug resistant organism <p>Chronic foley or suprapubic catheter</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Change q4 weeks Always colonized with bacteria – only treat for infection if symptomatic (hematuria, urgency, frequency, fever, chills) <p>Scrotal swelling</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Always obtain scrotal US Refer to urologist for hydrocele spermatocele or testicular mass present Refer to general surgery for hernias <p>Renal cyst</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Simple renal cyst. Always benign. No follow up indicated. Complex renal cyst. May be malignant. Urology referral recommended

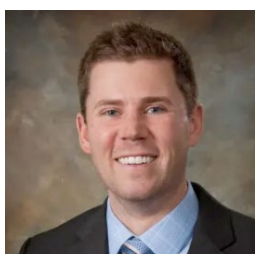

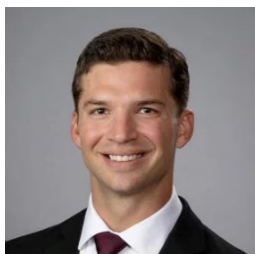

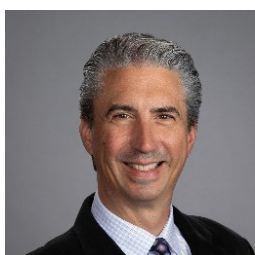
