Candidate Who can be referred?	Adults (18+). Patients with lung nodules detected on screening CT scans or incidentally on CT scans of the chest done for other purposes.	
Work-up What is required?	Some form of chest imaging, ideally within three months. If patient is referred off chest X-ray, non-contrast CT of chest should be performed before referral.

Services What clinical services and procedures are offered?	 Efficient multidisciplinary work-up of nodule, and ancillary testing before and after biopsy as necessary. Nodule biopsy via the lon robotic-assisted bronchoscopy platform, percutaneous CT guided biopsy or surgical lung biopsy. Not all nodules need biopsy. We will coordinate with referring providers to ensure timely follow-up and repeat imaging studies. 	• If malignant, clinic will refer patient to appropriate medical team for subsequent treatment planning. Clinical details will be discussed in multidisciplinary tumor board meeting and recommendations placed in electronic medical record for review by care team.
Collaboration How will we coordinate care for the patient?	 Our team uses the Epic electronic health record (EHR). For physicians and professional providers using Epic, you'll be copied on all notes related to the patient. For physicians and professional providers outside of Epic, notes will be faxed to you.
