Candidate Who can be referred?	Adults (18+) All lung conditions/sleep conditions, including COPD, asthma, emphysema, pulmonary fibrosis, bronchiectasis, bronchitis, pneumonia, pulmonary nodules, sleep apnea, insomnia, narcolepsy, restless leg syndrome, hemoptysis, pulmonary hypertension and abnormal chest imaging
Work-up What is required?	 A referral with last office note Pulmonary function testing prior to consultation preferred for most lung condition patients Specialty paperwork filled out X-ray may be required for certain diagnoses

On-site full pulmonary function testing Six-minute walk Bronchoscopy, including endobronchial ultrasound, navigational interventional and placement of fiducial markers Oxygen testing Polysomnography (PSG), home and lab sleep studies arranged through Deaconess Hospital Sleep Lab
Collaboration How will we coordinate care for the patient?	 Our team uses the Epic electronic health record (EHR). For physicians and professional providers using Epic, you'll be copied on all notes related to the patient. For physicians and professional providers outside Epic, notes will be faxed to you. Our physicians may be contacted at 509-342-3070.
Referral How do we refer?	 Epic users may refer to MultiCare Rockwood Pulmonary by using EPIC ID REF053 Epic users may refer to MultiCare Rockwood Sleep Medicine by using department codes: RWC DHEC Sleep Medicine RWC Spokane Valley Sleep Medicine Outside referrals, fax 509-459-1529 or call 509-342-3070. If you request an evaluation and management to a sleep provider that is one referral. If you request a sleep study performed at Deaconess Sleep Lab that is a separate referral and does not include evaluation or management. Most insurance plans are accepted. Prior authorization is needed for TriCare Prime, NPN, Humana Gold HMO and Aetna HMO. Given our high number of referrals, if a referral is deemed by provider to be urgent, provider-to-provider contact is recommended.
