<p>Work-up What is required?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A referral with last office note • Pulmonary function testing prior to consultation preferred for most lung condition patients • Specialty paperwork filled out • X-ray may be required for certain diagnoses

If you request a sleep study performed at Deaconess Sleep Lab that is a separate referral and does not include evaluation or management. • Most insurance plans are accepted. Prior authorization is needed for TriCare Prime, NPN, Humana Gold HMO and Aetna HMO. • Given our high number of referrals, if a referral is deemed by provider to be urgent, provider-to-provider contact is recommended.
