Work-up What is required?	 Must have one of the following payers: CMS Medicare Shared Savings Program, Embright HCA PEBB, Embright HCA SEBB, First Choice Employee Health PSR, First Choice Employee Health INW, Humana Medicare HMO, Humana Medicare PPO, University of Washington ACN Boeing, UHC MA Rockwood ACO Payers updated regularly, so ask clinic for updated information if payer not found Referring provider to send up-to-date reconciled medication list with patient or referral Physicians outside of MultiCare Health System Referral with detailed reason for being referred - i.e diagnosis, symptom, specific request(s), and/or helpful context with questions answered below Two or more chronic, life-limiting conditions (defined by HCC's)? Has the patient had 3 or more ED visits or 2 or more hospital admissions in the last 12 months? Does the patient have SDOH risk factors such as food insecurity, unhoused, transportation needs, caregiver needs?
