

## Lung Cancer Screening Program

<p><b>Candidate</b> Who can be referred?</p>	<p>Annual screening with low-dose computed tomography (LDCT) is recommended for all adults aged 50 to 80 who have a 20 pack-year smoking history (smoked one pack a day for 20 years or two packs a day for 10 years) and currently smoke or have quit within the past 15 years.</p>
<p><b>Work-up</b> What is required?</p>	<p>No work-up is required to refer a patient to the Lung Cancer Screening Program.</p>

<p><b>Services</b> What clinical services and procedures are offered?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Appointment coordination with MultiCare Imaging for low dose computed tomography (LDCT) scan that can show potential cancerous tumors when they are still small.</li> <li>• Any patient with a lung nodule discovered on CT imaging will be referred to our Lung Nodule Clinic.</li> <li>• If malignant, patient will be referred to the appropriate medical team for subsequent treatment planning.</li> <li>• All communication, appointment scheduling, patient education, surveillance and next steps will be coordinated by David Fine, PA-C.</li> </ul>
<p><b>Collaboration</b> How will we coordinate care for the patient?</p>	<p>Our team uses the Epic electronic health record (EHR).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• For physicians and professional providers using Epic, you'll be copied on all notes related to the patient.</li> <li>• For physicians and professional providers outside of Epic, notes will be faxed to you.</li> </ul>
