<p>Candidate Who can be referred?</p>	<p>Adults 18 and over who have been diagnosed with or are being evaluated for cancers of the prostate, bladder, kidney, testicles or other parts of the urinary tract, or who have abnormal imaging or lab results (such as elevated PSA levels or blood in the urine) that may indicate a urologic malignancy.</p>
<p>Work-up What is required?</p>	<p>To expedite the referral, please include relevant clinical documentation such as pathology reports, imaging studies (CT, MRI or ultrasound), and recent lab results (e.g., PSA, tumor markers). A referral note summarizing the diagnosis or concern—such as a known or suspected urologic malignancy—is also helpful.</p>
