<p>Candidate Who can be referred?</p>	<p>Men with PSMA-positive metastatic castration-resistant prostate cancer (mCRPC) who have progressed despite prior androgen receptor pathway inhibitor (ARPI) therapy.</p>	
<p>Work-up What is required?</p>	<p>To refer a patient, please provide imaging results of a PSMA PET/CT scan demonstrating PSMA-avid metastatic disease as well as all relevant chart information.</p>

<p>Services What clinical services and procedures are offered?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Comprehensive treatment planning and eligibility assessment. • Radioligand therapy administered via IV infusion every six weeks (up to six cycles). • Patient education on post-treatment precautions and safety. • Ongoing monitoring for and management of side effects. • Multidisciplinary collaboration with medical oncology, nuclear medicine, urology and other specialists to ensure integrated care and continuity through treatment. • Follow-up and dose adjustments based on patient response. 	
<p>Collaboration How will we coordinate care for the patient?</p>	<p>Our team uses the Epic electronic health record (EHR).</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • For physicians and professional providers using Epic or other interoperable EHR systems, you'll be copied on all notes related to the patient's care or they will be available via Care Everywhere in Epic. • For providers not using Epic or an EHR, notes will be faxed to you. 	
<p>Referral How do we refer?</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Epic users: Refer directly to Radiation Oncology at MultiCare Cancer Institute by selecting TG RADIATION THERAPY (Tacoma) or CAP AJB PAV RAD ONCOLOGY (Olympia) and including "Radioligand Therapy" in the comments field. • Non-Epic users: Fax referral requests, relevant notes, imaging and lab results to the appropriate clinic location.
