For Epilepsy and Seizure referrals, an MRI of the brain and EEG are preferred but not required, and patients will be seen without these studies. For all referrals, please include the reason for referral, relevant clinic notes and any prior imaging or test results.</p>

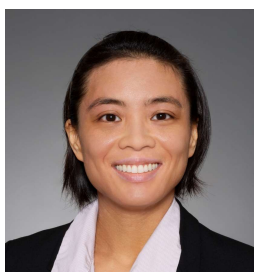

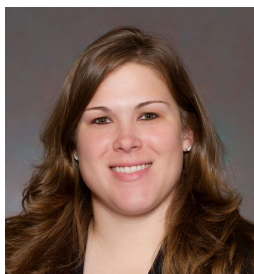
